



JOB POSTING **COMMUNITY HEALTH NAVIGATOR**

The Uncas Health District has an immediate opening for a **part-time Community Health Navigator** to support the Connecticut Early Detection and Prevention Program (CEDPP) and the Connecticut Well Integrated Screening and Evaluation for Women Across the Nation (WISEWOMAN) Program. CEDPP is a comprehensive screening program and the WISEWOMAN Program provides heart disease screening throughout Connecticut for medically underserved women.

The primary job duties include in-reach/outreach activities, providing screening services, public/client and professional education, and quality assurance and data collection.

The candidate must possess a high school diploma and a driver's license in the State of Connecticut.

The position is a part-time, grant funded, contracted position for 21 hours per week.
